OCTOBER - THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY

The month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary, one of the best known of all Catholic devotions. The best way to celebrate this month is, of course, to pray the Rosary.

Tips to Pray the Rosary Daily

- 1. Carry a rosary in your pocket.
- 2. Recite when doing chores or while you work out or run/walk.
- 3. Pray while you walk and think of the people in your life or pray for a situation that worries you.
- Say it while you wait (e.g. at the bus stop, at the doctors surgery, for your child to come out from school)
 Fall asleep saying the Rosary.
- 6. If you can't pray the whole Rosary at once, break it into parts throughout the day.
- 7. Join with the friends you didn't know you had join with those who pray the rosary at church or in local rosary groups.
