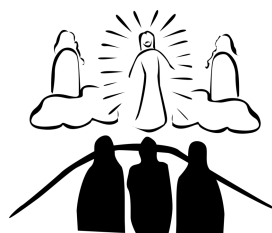


BEING TRANSFIGURED
