DIPLOMA IN PASTORAL THEOLOGY

Drumalis Retreat Centre, in association with St. Patrick's Pontifical College, Maynooth, invites applications for this two-year, part-time, intensive course which begins in September 2021. The course will run on the basis of 6 in-house days and 18 evening sessions per year for two years. The main aim of this course is to equip people for skilled and supervised active lay ministry within a parish or church community. The course is knowledge and skill-based and grounded in experiential learning. During the course, participants will:

- study and reflect on Christian life and ministry,
- Combine pastoral theology and the acquisition of skills with supervised experience in pastoral placements,
- Develop the skills of theological reflection, so as to enable them to relate theology and ministry to everyday life,
- Engage in ongoing formation of social, organisational, communication and leadership skills.
