RE-OPENING OF CHURCHES IN NORTHERN IRELAND

As you may be aware, the Northern Bishops have announced a cautious return to public worship for the faithful from Friday 26 March, in time for the celebration of Holy Week and Easter.

- The Bishops emphasise the need for continued caution and a rigorous application of all mitigations and safeguards required to ensure the safest possible return to public worship in our Churches.
- Following consultation with our own parish Covid-19 Support Team and after a thorough risk assessment, we have decided that public worship will commence in Cappagh Parish on Friday 26 March 2021.
- In emphasising the cautious nature of this return to public worship, Bishops remind the faithful that the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days remains suspended; and every person should consider carefully if returning to collective worship is the safe and appropriate step for them, at this time.
- Parishioners who attend Mass must do so under the guidance of current Covid-19 restrictions:
- 1. Anyone who is feeling unwell or displaying symptoms of COVID-19 should <u>not</u> attend Mass.
- 2. <u>Masks/face coverings must be worn in Church</u> and upon entering and exiting.
- 3. On entry, an usher will welcome you and spray your hands with <u>sanitiser</u> (also upon leaving).
- 4. An usher will show you to a seat. We ask for your patience if an usher is not immediately available.
- 5. When entering and exiting the church please *maintain a safe social distance from others*.
- 6. When arriving and leaving Mass please *do not gather outside*.
- There *will not* be a booking system for attendance at Mass.
- It is important to note that Weddings and Funerals will continue to be subject to the relevant state regulations in terms of the numbers that can attend.
