

"Do This In Memory" 2021/2022: Enrolment Meeting



Will take place in Christ the King Church on Wednesday 3 November at 8.15pm. <u>Attendance at this meeting is essential</u> to ensure your child is registered for the programme. Due to restrictions, attendance is limited to the child plus one parent/guardian to accompany them.

Parishioners who attend Mass must do so under the guidance of current Covid-19 restrictions:

- 1. Anyone who is feeling unwell or displaying symptoms of COVID-19 should *not* attend Mass.
- 2. We ask that you wear a mask/face covering inside the church and upon entering and exiting.
- 3. On entry, an usher will welcome you and spray your hands with sanitiser (also upon leaving).
- 4. An usher will show you to a seat. We ask for your patience if an usher is not immediately available.
- 5. When entering and exiting the church please maintain a safe social distance from others.
- 6. When arriving and leaving Mass please do not gather outside.
